This learning experience aims to introduce one of the most famous archeological finds in the world: Qing Shi Huangdi's mausoleum and its terracotta warriors. Explore Chinese history and reflect on the past.

Students will learn more about the terracotta warriors, their famous tomb, archeology and life in the past with a presentation and a 'digging out' objects activity followed by a clay modelling session to create their own army of terracotta warriors.
